



POSITION: Camp Medic

QUALIFICATION:

- Minimum of 19 years of age
- High school graduate, some college preferred, or equivalent experience
- Experience significant to working with children and providing medical care in a camp setting, Wilderness First Responder (WFR) level or higher medical training
- Familiarity and compatibility with Quaker values

RESPONSIBLE TO: Camp Director and to your fellow staff members and the campers

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Leadership and guidance in areas of health, hygiene and safety precautions
- Respond to illness and injury at camp
- Be an excellent role model for all campers and staff members

RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Collect, organize and dispense all medications campers bring to camp
- Oversee health and hygiene procedures at camp in coordination with camp director
- Coordinate camp response to illness and injury, in consultation with camp director. Serve as first responder, provide instruction to other staff, and consult with medical professionals offsite of camp as necessary
- Maintain detailed and accurate health log, "SOAP" reports of every medical event, including collecting notes from other staff and reporting to Camp Director
- Before camp, coordinate with camp director to insure first aid supplies are in good order and present at camp
- Maintain first aid treatment center, and pack first aid kits for excursions
- Attend, lead, and participate in meeting for worship
- Attend staff meetings regularly and relay information to other staff not present; contribute as necessary
- Participate in the spiritual, emotional, and physical growth of all
- Prepare written evaluation at the end of the summer following the guidelines provided by the Camp Director
- Serve as program and/or kitchen staff, as time permits. Most days your medic duties will only be a small part of your job, but you must be prepared to act when needed
- Other duties as assigned
