



POSITION: Program Staff and Cabin Counselor

QUALIFICATION:

- Minimum of 18 years of age (all ages of adults encouraged to apply, and exception may be made for certain individuals who have graduated from high school at age 17)
- High school graduate, some college preferred, or equivalent experience
- Some experience significant to working with children in a camp setting
- Familiarity and compatibility with Quaker values

RESPONSIBLE TO: Camp Director and to your fellow staff members and the campers

GENERAL RESPONSIBILITIES:

- Leadership and guidance of cabin group and program groups for youth ages of 10-17
- Lead and teach small and large group activities
- Be an excellent role model with all campers and staff members

SPECIFIC RESPONSIBILITIES

- Live with small group of campers and help each camper adjust and grow in relation to other campers and camp life; and monitor daily hygiene of each camper
- Work cooperatively with all other staff members to plan, implement, and evaluate the program
- Interpret philosophy, rules and regulations of the camp, with special attention to safety and health regulations for the campers
- Guide each individual camper in their participation in group activities as needed
- Assist with all camp program activities and other camp wide activities as assigned
- Act as host at meal times and lead camper cleanups responsibly
- Attend, lead, and participate in meeting for worship
- Attend staff meetings regularly and relay information to other staff not present; contribute as necessary
- Participate in the spiritual, emotional, and physical growth of all
- Prepare written evaluation at the end of the summer following the guidelines provided by the Camp Director
- Other duties as assigned
